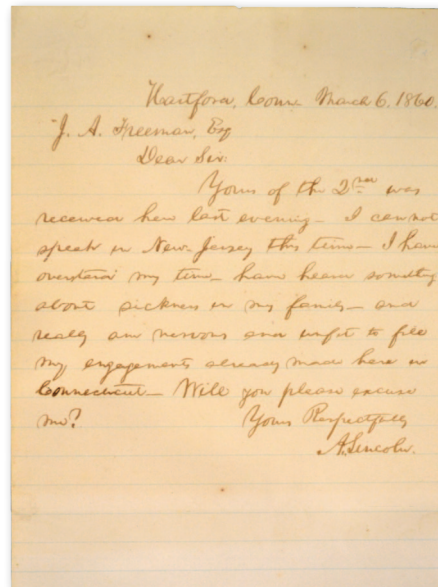
- **Thomas Jefferson** – His descendants turned to us to sell his last letter home from the White House, written to his daughter (pictured);
